We have a 35-person membership cap in order to keep our collective very defined and to insure each artist does not get lost in the mix.

*If you are interested in submitting your work to us, please do the following:*

- 1) E-mail the URL to your website top us at [info@aoacollective.com](mailto:info@aoacollective.com). **ALL** potential members **must** have their own individual website that properly exhibits the scope of their work, as well as current available pieces. Sending us links to your page(s) on another art site(s) simply will not do. Since we are an online art collective, we require that all members have their own website that is regularly kept **CURRENT** to properly promote their work. You must also have a links page in order to properly link AOA from your website (which will include the addition of an official AOA banner, should your membership be accepted).
- 2) Should you happen to sell your work on auction websites, like eBay™, please send us the link to your current auctions. Please note: selling your work on eBay™ is **NOT** a prerequisite to be considered for membership, but since several current members began their art careers by selling on eBay™ before they transcended to gallery shows, we would like to review your auctions, as well.
- 3) If you are on MySpace, please also forward us the URL to your MySpace page. It is not a requirement to have a MySpace page, however, if you do, it is required that you add the AOA MySpace page and list it proudly in your Top Friends should your membership be accepted.

Once we receive your submission, our voting board will review your work and determine whether we feel your art fits the scope, direction and needs of the current AOA roster of artists. Should you be accepted into AOA, you will be provided with all the requirements & guidelines you need to provide to get your information up on our website, as well as to properly include all our information on your website.

As AOA is completely self-supported, PLEASE NOTE that membership is FREE, however donations are accepted in order to help offset the costs of maintenance and web hosting. Should you wish to contribute, it would be *greatly appreciated but not required*. As of this writing, we are currently exploring certain avenues to sell AOA-sanctioned merchandise in an online store to be included on our website, so more information on that will be provided to members as it becomes available.

In the end, sure, it all may sound a bit intimidating, but it really isn't. We just want the *very best*, and in that, we also only want those artists that are willing to be as dedicated as we are to AOA. Our membership and collector base spans the globe, and we look forward to the possibility of having you onboard for our revolution!
